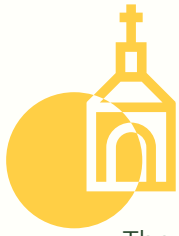

# internships

## WITH MOYO MISSIONS

- Internships to Uganda are 90 days or less
- Average trip cost is \$4,695 and includes:
  - Application Fee
  - Airfare (about 20 hours of travel)
  - Accommodations (in-country hotels and stay at the Village of Eden)
  - Transportation
  - Ministry Opportunities
  - Tourism Opportunities
  - Mission Trip Insurance
- Medications/Vaccinations for travel:
  - Yellow Fever (required)
  - Typhoid (highly recommended)
  - Antimalarial medication (required)
  - Traveler's Diarrhea medication (required)
  - All medications/vaccines are the responsibility of the intern and are NOT included in the trip cost
- Physical Requirements for Team Members:
  - Walk 3+ miles daily
  - Tolerate constant heat without air conditioning
  - Travel long distances in planes, cars, and buses
  - Perform ministry for up to 12 hours daily
  - Carry and manage all personal luggage (50LB suitcase, carry-on bag, and personal item)
  - Receive required vaccines and medications
- All team members must purchase a tourist visa prior to the mission trip
  - Visas are the responsibility of the team member and are NOT included in the trip cost
- Ministry Opportunities
  - Children's discipleship
  - Community evangelism
  - Serving at the Village of Eden Primary and Secondary Schools
  - Serving at local schools with games, purity talks, and hygiene classes
  - Serving at the Village of Eden Baby Home
  - Medical Missions
- Tourism opportunities are available to add to the end of a trip and range from an additional \$50-\$2000 per person
  - Additional cost will be added to the total trip cost



- Total Uganda Internship Investment
  - Application Fee - \$200
  - Airfare (estimated cost of \$2,000-\$2,800)
  - Ground Expenses - \$1795
    - Accommodations
    - Meals
    - Transportation
    - Ministry Opportunities
    - Tourism Opportunities (will add \$150-\$2000 per person)
    - Mission Trip Insurance
  - Personal Expenses (responsibility of the team member)
    - Visa - \$50
    - Vaccinations and Medications - \$60-\$540
      - Yellow Fever Vaccine (required) - estimated cost - \$275
      - Typhoid Vaccine (highly recommended) - estimated cost - \$155
      - Antimalarial Medication (required) - estimated cost - \$50-\$100
      - Traveler's Diarrhea Medication (required) - estimated cost - \$10
    - Airport meals - \$50+
    - Snacks - \$25+
    - Personal Expenses (groceries, meals out, etc.) - \$350 per month
    - Souvenirs - \$25-\$150

**TOTAL AVERAGE INVESTMENT FOR 90 DAY INTERNSHIP - \$6,295**

#### EXPECTATIONS OF INTERNS:

At Moyo Missions, interns are representatives of Jesus and of our ministry, therefore, we expect interns to:

- Follow the same code of conduct as our missionaries
- Be flexible, adapting to different schedules, cultures, and ministry needs
- Follow rules and guidelines given prior to departure and upon arrival for safety, accountability, and growth
- Be physically prepared for daily heat, long ministry days, and walking most of the day
